An Advanced Shipment Notice is an email that is sent to a customer that contains the packing list of their shipment on that day. Ann Austad, our Logistics Manager, comments, "We create an extra copy of the packing list that the driver pulls and leaves for me as he is loading it on the truck. Then, I can confidently say that it is on the truck." This early notice aids our customers to plan their workload in an efficient way, with reliable information.

This notice also saves our customers and AFI time. The time it takes for a customer to send a request to AFI, AFI to get the correct information and send it back can, in many cases, be frustrating for everyone involved. This process streamlines that information and cuts out the time and effort of the many who are involved. Advanced Shipment Notices help keep AFI organized and confident that every customer has the information they need.

You may be asking yourself, when will these notices start? They have already started! We have received great feedback from customers who have appreciated the information. Ann states, "Many of our customers really depend on the information. They can relay that information on to their customers in a timely fashion. It puts answers in their hands and they don't have to wait for a call back from us because they have the packing list right in front of them." AFI hopes that Advanced Shipment Notices will better the communication between us and our customers and, ultimately, create a stronger relationship.

Behind the Scenes Look at AFI's Team

Ann Austad Logistics Manager

Words to describe shipping departments of many companies are usually along the lines of busy, stressful, and chaotic. A strong leader must be in place to ensure organization is a top priority. AFI is lucky to have one of those leaders, Ann Austad.

Ann grew up on a farm south of Mankato, MN. Throughout her childhood, she was very active in sports and 4-H. She was a five letter athlete in high school including taking stats for the football team and being the first female manager for the boys baseball team (softball wasn't offered at that time).

During her senior year in high school Ann joined the National Guard and spent the next nine years serving our country, as a Supply Specialist. She also worked in the retail and accounting industries for the next twenty years.

About ten years ago, AFI was trying to fill an HR/IT position. John knew Ann was the right person for the job the instant he interviewed Ann and cancelled his other interviews for that position. When asked about all of her roles Ann responded, "Each has offered a totally different aspect of areas that are vitally important to the company." Ann works tirelessly to ensure that correct quantity shipments and on time deliveries are made to our valued customers. Currently, Ann runs a fleet of three trucks with a fourth on the way. She works with Jammey and Ryan everyday to ensure the right parts are moving through the shipping department and

communicating that information to our customers as quickly as possible.

When asked what she loves about AFI, Ann said, "I am very appreciative of the management style of John and Ted. They work well together and with our management


